Well, the week began with some bleary eyes and excited chatter following the late night win for England in the World Cup.

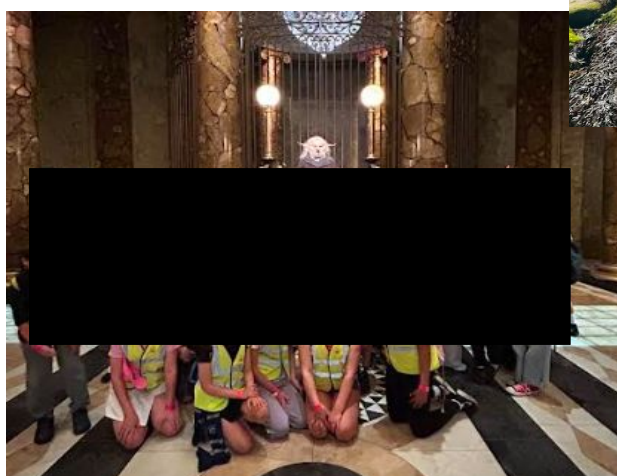
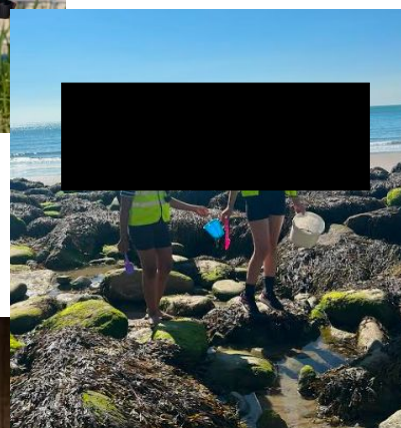
