Chinese New Year **Paper Lanterns**

This year Chinese New Year falls on Friday 12th February, so we thought it would be a nice idea to suggest an Art activity for you to create, to help celebrate. The website China Family Adventure have created some wonderful examples of paper lanterns, which look intricate and detailed to provide a challenge for KS2 children.

For this activity you will need:

- One sheet red paper
- Two to three sheets gold paper
- Pencil and Ruler
- Scissors
- Glue
- Sellotape
- Stapler

You could use any coloured paper. Gold and red have been chosen, as they are traditionally lucky colours to celebrate Chinese New Year. Or if you do not have coloured paper, you could decorate your plain paper first.
