Dear Parents/Carers

We hope that you are all well and are coping through these difficult times. It is with great excitement that we are able to have all the children back in from Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2021.

Now that the Government have released the guidelines for how schools will operate from 8 March, we would like to share with you what will happen.

We are delighted to say that all children are expected to return to school and we are so looking forward to welcoming them back. We have really missed having them here.

In accordance with Government directives, all children will be based in their own class bubble and will have staggered times for starting and finishing school, playtimes and lunches. We will be running both breakfast and after school clubs along bubble lines. If you wish your child to attend please inform Mrs Perkins, [kperkins@st-eanswythes.kent.sch.uk](mailto:kperkins@st-eanswythes.kent.sch.uk), as soon as possible.

We are limiting items travelling between home and school. However, children will need to bring a bottle of water as the water fountains are turned off. They may also bring in a packed lunch box if they do not want a school meal. Children will need to bring their reading books and P.E. kits. If they require a bag it must be small and fit inside their lockers. Nothing else is required from home.

In line with the Government guidelines parents will need to socially distance from each other and staff when dropping off and collecting their children. As previously, we will be using staggered start and finish times and entrances. These are listed below so that you will be clear on when to collect and drop off your child. The times are strict and must be so in order to maintain bubble integrity. If you are late and miss your slot you must then wait until 9am and drop your child through the front entrance. Similarly, you need to be on time to collect your child as we will have nowhere for them to wait. If you have any questions please don't hesitate to contact us.
